The TBA Collective require all works to be with them by 21/11/22 and any unsold works to be collected by 28/11/22.

Works can be delivered and collected in person, which can be arranged via email. If works can be posted all costs, insurances and any damages are the responsibility of the artist. This includes return posting of any unsold works.

Please indicate how you will transport works to and from the exhibition.

If works can be digitally printed locally all costs are the responsibility of the artist, as is the return of the printed works if unsold.

Admin Fee

Successful applicants will be charged a £20, non-refundable admin fee. This fee will be put towards the running of the exhibition, and the private view. The fee should be paid to a member of The TBA Collective as soon as possible after selections have been made.

This will be arranged separately via email, to find the most suitable payment method. Payment must be received prior to the delivery of works, failure to do so will result in work not being included in the exhibition.

Terms and Conditions

1. The open call accepts submissions from all artists over the age of 18
2. All works must fit the theme 'carnival'
3. Only one entry per person, of a maximum of 4 images
4. Payment from successful applicants is to be made to a member of the TBA Collective prior to the delivery of artworks
5. All works remain 100% copyright of the artist
6. The artist allows images of their work and their name to be used for promotional purposes for the exhibition, including in potential publications, social media, and promotion via third parties
7. All artwork must be original and 100% copyright of the artist
8. All mediums of work shall be considered
9. Once paid, the £20 admin fee of successful applicants is non-refundable
10. The TBA Collective accept no responsibility of any damages to works during the transport to or from the exhibition space
11. The TBA Collective will invigilate the exhibition. They will be responsible for the space, hanging the works and opening and closing the space. The TBA Collective accepts no responsibility for theft, accidental damages from members of the public or damages from other unforeseen circumstances e.g. fire, water damage, etc.
12. Personal data from submissions will not be shared with any other parties
13. Artists contact details will only be used by The TBA Collective for enquiries concerning the exhibition
14. Successful applicants shall be contacted via email and should respond as soon as possible to secure their place within the exhibition.
15. Depending on the volume of submissions the TBA Collective may not be able to reply to unsuccessful applicants. Successful applicants shall be contacted by 08/11/22
